



THE JB MINING SERVICES GEOLOGY HONOURS SCHOLARSHIP

(Established in 2007 and maintained by an annual gift of \$2,000 from JB Mining Services Pty Ltd to encourage and assist a meritorious student in financial need in the Bachelor of Science (Honours) program in the field of geology.)

1. The scholarship is awarded annually by Senate on the recommendation of the Head, School of Earth Sciences (the "Head").
2. To assist in the selection process, the Head, School of Earth Sciences must establish a selection committee chaired by the Head, or nominee, comprised of a representative of JB Mining Services Pty Ltd and academic staff teaching in the geology discipline, with the academic staff forming the majority.
3. The scholarship is open to students who -
 - (a) are domestic students as defined in the Fee Rules; and
 - (b) have completed the Bachelor of Science program, in the field of geology, in the year immediately preceding; and
 - (c) are studying full-time; and
 - (d) are enrolled in the first semester of the Bachelor of Science (Honours) program, in the field of geology, for the first time.
4. The scholarship is awarded, at the discretion of the selection committee, to the applicant showing the greatest merit as demonstrated by -
 - (a) financial need; and
 - (b) academic achievement during the Bachelor of Science program; and
 - (c) an interest in geology; and
 - (d) personal qualities, including leadership potential; and
 - (e) other evidence as may be deemed relevant to future success in the geology profession in Australia,
with preference given to students from rural areas of Australia.
5. The scholarship is paid in half-yearly instalments and is subject to continued full-time enrolment in the program.
6. The scholarship may be deferred only with the approval of the Head.
7. The value of the scholarship is \$2,000 for one year.
